Avistrum Academy Makes Pact with Galactic Empire

Transfiguration Bill Advances

SALEM, Mass. – A controversial new bill banning the teaching of Transfiguration moved out of a crucial subcommittee yesterday on a straight party-line vote. HWB739, The PREvention of Transfiguration ENhanced Deception (PRETEND) Act, was advanced by the House of Warlocks' Abuse of Magic subcommittee with a "pass" recommendation.

The five members of the subcommittee split 3-2 on the bill, with the three Grand Old Mages party members voting aye, and the 2 members of the Progressive Wizards' Party voting nay.

"Obviously, we realize this bill will force difficult changes in our educational system," Subcommittee chair-witch Eileen Lampkin (GOM-Winchendon, MA) stated at a press conference yesterday afternoon. "Unfortunately, we need the PRE-TEND Act to safeguard our society (Continued on page 2)

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from Transfiguration-using terrorists like Persephone. I know that my fellow wizards and witches will ultimately recognize that these restrictions are necessary for the continued well-being of our society."

The bill, sponsored by Norris Woodby (GOM-Arkadelphia, AR), will come before the full Committee for the Regulation of Dangerous Magical Practices sometime next month.

In addition to prohibiting the teaching of Transfiguration, the PRETEND Act would also make it a felony to use Transfiguration for the purposes of deceiving law enforcement, which is currently a misdemeanor. Critics contend that it will make practically all Transfiguration illegal.

Already expected to testify at hearings for the bill is Avistrum Academy of Sorcery's Polonius Aberfoyle, Head of Parador House

Italian Quidditch Champion New Avistrum Coach

The companion bill in the Wizards' Senate, WSB43, is scheduled for hearings before the Senate Committee on Magical Perversions in early June.

Timmernak Boys School Destroyed

NOVA SCOTIA - In a sketchy press release from the Ministry of Magic in Halifax, officials are reporting that the famed Timmernak Wizarding Academy for Boys has been destroyed after months of continuous attacks.

"We are fortunate that casualties have been low, thanks to an early evacuation of most students and faculty from the school," said a senior Ministry official in the release.
